Year 1 Phonics Check

It is national phonics screening for Year 1 children next week. We don't make a fuss about this with the children. However, any additional reading at home over the next few days will just ensure that they are as confident as possible with their reading next week. Your children know all of the sounds and all it does is test their knowledge of segmenting and blending words to read both real and nonsense words. We have attached a link: Phonics screening check: information for parents - GOV.UK, so that you know what the test looks like for them and here is a link to previous years tests, should you want any further understanding. Please do not hesitate to talk to your class teacher if you require any further information.

Class Organisation and Staffing

At this time of year, we are not only planning for this term but also for the next academic year. To this end, please see below our organisation of classes and class teachers. From September, we will be having two classes as we lend Miss Bowen to Longhorsley to cover a maternity leave there. We are very excited to have another Federation baby on the way, so huge congratulations to Mrs Hall and family, and welcome back to Longhorsley, Miss Bowen! Class teachers and children will continue to be well supported with our team of teaching assistants too. We will be trialling this model of two classes every morning from Week 3 of this half term. Miss Bowen will remain with us, although she will be occasionally visiting Longhorsley too.

In addition, from September, we will also be having Miss Mattison, who teaches at Longhorsley, coming to Whalton one day every week to set up and lead our new outdoor learning sessions, which will complement our Commando Joe missions around teamwork, risk taking and building resilience. Initially, it will be a focus on outdoor learning and then in January, we will be officially offering Forest School as part of our curriculum during the school day, for our youngest children to start with.

In line with Chantry Middle and Ponteland High School, we will be having our transition days-where the children get to visit their new class/class teacher (if it isn't the same one!) on Thursday 3rd and Friday 4th July. This is when our new Reception children will be coming to visit us too from PAWS.
