Diary Dates

To help you look ahead to the next academic year, we will be sending out next years' diary dates next week so that you can plan any time off work and holidays using the dates - we do have training days on Fridays and Mondays, so please use these to get reductions in costs! We will continue to add and update these term by term and resend them out to you.

School Lunches

Miss Johnson continues to cook fabulous wholesome meals for our children and we very much need your support to keep our school dinners alive- they are delicious! The cost of a school lunch will now be £2.75 a day from September for Year 3 children upwards. These are payable on a weekly basis, or half termly. Please remember that children on packed lunches can also sign up for school lunches - very popular on Fridays or when we are celebrating a certain time of the year - please just email school and we will sort.

Outstanding Monies

Thank you for keeping up to date with your gateway payments, however, please do not be offended if we remind you of the need to pay as, unfortunately, we still do have some outstanding payments (currently £1,981), so if these can be settled by Friday please, especially any children who are leaving, including for the weekly swimming bus, we would be very grateful. Many thanks for your support with this.

If you ever wish for your child to go on packed lunch, we do require at least two weeks' notice as a minimum please for food orders, however, we really do need your continued support for our kitchen to be viable, so having as many children on school dinners really helps with this and Miss Johnson is always very flexible.

Improvements to School

Looking ahead to September, we have plans to improve our fencing and school gates, following a successful bid back in February through the Diocese. As a Church school, we are extremely fortunate to be able to bid for funding that we can then use to improve our building and grounds. I will keep you updated!

Font Alliance

Last year, we joined an informal alliance with Cambo First School, Longhorsley C of E First School, Morpeth First School, Ponteland Community Primary School, Rothbury First School and Tritlington First School. We really hope that you will agree that this has had a positive impact on our children, especially in relation to football and sports, and meeting other children of the same age too, who they will meet again as they continue their educational journey. The Font Alliance has definitely benefited our staff and we have lots more shared training booked, such as Safeguarding and Trauma Attachment on our first training days in September, as well as joint moderation of children's writing standards throughout the year.
