Start and Finishing times of the School Day

School opens at 8.40am for 8.50am in all year groups. If children could come straight into school please, rather than lining up on the grid so we get a really prompt start, that would help support the staff to get the children settled and ready to learn straight away. Any problems, please let us know. On entering their classroom, children 'check in' using the zones of regulation (coloured emotion monsters in class 1!) supported by staff, to ensure that all children have the very best start, ready to learn and have fun! At home time, children are led out in their classes and dismissed by their teachers in the playground at 3.20pm to a known adult. If children are in Year 5 or 6, they can walk home by themselves, as long as school receives an email to let us know that this is what you would like your child to do.

Please remember to let the office know if someone other than parents are picking up your child for safeguarding reasons and to share this information with them please, on the 'who can my child go home with' list, thank you. We will always check if they aren't on the list, so please do not be offended if we then ring you as parents to check. Safety of all of our children is paramount.
