Key Information

We ask for children to come dressed in their PE Kit on a Tuesday and Thursday ONLY unless we have special event days.

Children have a weekly spelling and test on a Tuesday which they need extra home practise for and our expectation for reading at home 2-3 days per week, for children to build their fluency, as by the end of Year 2 children are expected to read a minimum of 90 words per minute!

~Art and Design or ~Design and Technology~

In Design and Technology, we will talk about the Eat Well Plate and make our own snack. We will learn how to prepare fruit and vegetables to make a dish. We will be practising our essential skills before we make our end product - cutting, slicing, grating, chopping ...

~Literacy~

This term, we are diving into Meerkat Mail and The Day the Crayons Quit.

For Poetry, we will study various poems and write our own original pieces.

Our class text is The Owl Who was Afraid of the Dark.



~P.E~

For PE, we have Liz from the Skipping School who is teaching us how to use a rope properly as well as teaching us how to skip as a team using the long rope.

~PSHE~

For PSHE, we will be continuing our conversations around wellbeing discussing our emotions and how they affect us.

We will also explore practical steps for the children to take when they are not feeling OK.

~Mathematics~

In Maths, we are working on the children's use of methods to solve addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Then using this knowledge to solve problems related to money and fractions.



~Science~

In Science, we are going to investigate animals and plants. Discussing things which are alive and things which aren't, as well as exploring habitats and microhabitats.

~History or Geography~

In Geography, we will continue to learn about the UK and compare it with Kenya in Eastern Africa. We will look at the features of each country, including, homes and transport, comparing their similarities and differences.

~R.E~

For R.E, our key question is - Who do Christians say made the World? In this unit of work, we will be exploring the Creation story and reflecting on how we can look after our planet today.



~Computing~

Computing, we will learn how to use scratch to create and move our own 'sprite'

~Music~

In Music, we will explore improvisation and how music makes us happy. Children will listen, sing, play instruments and perform.
