


Year 2 English: Summer 2020-2021

<p>We will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• listen to a story and answer questions• tell a story from memory• develop detail in the opening scene• use prepositional phrases of place• make inferences based on what is said and done• box up for purpose• explore how writers create openings that hook• write an opening that hooks (setting focus)• write an opening that hooks (action focus)• write an opening that hooks (character focus)	<p>We will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• read short texts and recall facts and information we have learned• say what common nouns and proper nouns are• say what adjectives and adverbs are• write a description using adjectives, adverbs and descriptive phrases• read and understand a short story about information texts• list and explain some typical features of information texts• create an alphabetically-ordered glossary• use information texts to research a topic we are interested in• sort sentences into different types – statements, commands, questions and exclamations• use expanded noun phrases in our labels• use alliteration, question marks or exclamation marks to create a title• compose a series of sentences on a theme• edit sentences we have written to spot mistakes with spelling and punctuation• make changes to our writing to improve the quality and accuracy of what we want to say	<p>We will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• relate poems to my own experiences• discuss words and phrases from poems and their meaning• discuss and plan ideas for our own poem• remember parts of a poem and say them out loud• recognise apostrophes in contractions• recognise where apostrophes are needed in contractions• recognise where apostrophes are required to indicate possession• talk about the features of a poem• discuss what we like or dislike about a poem and why• discuss features of a poem including <i>onomatopoeia</i>• understand how word choices can create different effects• choose our own words to create different effects• write spoken speech
