


Literacy

This term we will continue to focus on producing handwriting that is of a consistently high standard. We will work on the spelling of our Key Stage 2 common exception words. We will be learning how to structure, plan and write non-chronological reports, and will focus on humorous poetry before the end of term.

Numeracy

We will be covering the topics of multiplication, division, money, length & perimeter and statistics this term. As we do this, we will continue think about how we can use our mathematical skills in everyday life, and develop our reasoning and problem-solving skills.



Science

In Science this Spring, we will look at the different states of matter. We will sort and describe materials, investigate the properties of gases, solids and liquids, and learn about the significance of the water cycle.

Computing

This term, computing tasks will involve looking at creating computer coding and programs, so that we can bring sequences of commands to life! We will also ensure that we continue to be mindful about how to use computers and the internet safely.

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Religious Education

We will look at the concepts of the Gospel and incarnation this term. We will find about why the Gospel is so important in Christianity and how it helps Christians to behave in the correct way.

Geography

In Geography this term, we will find out about volcanoes, earthquakes, tsunamis and tornadoes. We will learn about what causes these physical phenomena and how they can have a huge impact on our lives.



History

In History, we will investigate the causes of World War II, the roles and responsibilities of the British armed forces and how this historical event is remembered today.

Music

Our ukulele lessons will continue this term. We will focus on playing and performing with increasing accuracy, and how to use our aural memory to recall sounds correctly.

Commando Joe's

This term, we will complete a number of new Commando Joe missions. This programme will help the children to develop many important skills including teamwork, resilience and cooperation.



Art, Design & Technology

This term, we will think about how to develop our own original ideas, what materials can be used in the design process, how to make sketches and models to bring our ideas to life!



Physical Education

In the Spring term, we look at the variety of skills needed to be an accomplished gymnast. We will learn a selection of techniques to help us improve our balance, strength and flexibility when performing a range of gymnastic exercises.

PSHE

This term, we will be focusing on the ideas of family and community. We will find out about the importance of relationships within family life, and how a community can be made up of a variety of complementary groups.
