

This fun and engaging UKS2 Ancient Greece Topic will take Year 5 and Year 6 back to one of the most fascinating civilisations in history, as they explore ancient Greece and its many wonders. Through this series of learning, Class 3 will discover the people, the inventions, the art, the technology and the mythology of the ancient Greeks throughout Spring Term 2021.



### History

As we rewind the clocks in our History lessons, to the times of Ancient Greece, we will begin by placing events on a time line before delving deeper into different aspects of life as an Ancient Greek. From myths, warfare, and daily life, to religion, Athens and Sparta. We will then present all our newly learned information in an engaging classroom display.



### Design and Technology

Our class of designers will be working their magic in designing and making a labyrinth after hearing the story of 'Theseus and the Minotaur'. Our skills don't stop there however, we will then take on the challenge of making a model of the Parthenon after studying its complex design.

### Computing

In computing, we will be using a range of programmes (Microsoft word, PowerPoint and 2 Simple Software) to present our ideas in a range of platforms. We will also be continuing to develop our understanding of how to ensure we remain safe whilst using the internet; making the right choices and knowing how to approach different online scenarios.



### Geography

As Geographers we will be looking at the physical geography of Greece. We will then be developing our understanding of Greece today; investigating the population and exploring their culture. We will also gain an understanding of rivers; developing our geographical skills and field work.



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### Art

In Art we will explore, experiment with and understand the use of different materials. This will be achieved through a varied range of art platforms that we will be looking at; along with the significance that the varied pieces held with the Ancient Greeks.



### Science

Our 'States of Matter' Science focus this term is the perfect way for us to learn about the differences between solids, liquids and gases, and how different materials can change state. We will have plenty of opportunities to undertake practical experiments to help us understand the processes of evaporation and condensation, as well as expressing our understanding in a variety of ways.



### RE

We will use our Bibles to link stories about the people of God, with lessons in our own lives. We will also be looking at the importance of following God's wishes, in the religion of Judaism. As we approach the end of term, we will be exploring the Easter story and the history of Easter Symbols.



### PE

In PE, we will be taking part in gymnastics before finishing the Spring Term with football. Mr Brown will be teaching PE for the rest of the year, as we send well-wishes with Mrs Lee-Turner throughout her maternity leave.
