



<p>We will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • discuss characters, sequencing and plot • explore descriptive writing • identify prepositions and expanded noun phrases <p>We will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • retell the story from different viewpoints • plan and write a letter from a character • use co-ordinating and subordinating conjunctions in writing extended sentences • plan and write a similar story of their own 	<p>We will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • identify the differences between fiction & factual writing • identify and understand the difference between co-ordination and subordination • identify the tenses used commonly in different types of text, e.g. present tense in factual writing, past tense when writing a diary • study features of biographical writing <p>We will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • prepare a short information text • use co-ordinating and subordinating conjunctions appropriately • change sentences from one tense to another • plan and write a biography 	<p>We will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • read a variety of poems and look at features • understand the terms verse, free verse, rhyme and rhythm. • analyse different poems and decide which they prefer, writing about their reasons • identify nouns and adjectives • identify prepositional phrases <p>We will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • write questions, exclamations and statements • build expanded noun phrases in our own writing • write, re-draft and perform our own poems
