Reminders: Please could the children continue to come to school dressed in PE kit every Thursday.


Weekly Events:

Spellings: Every **Wednesday**, starting Wednesday 6th January, we shall continue our spelling tests. The spellings were sent home last term. The marked spelling book will be sent home on Wednesday night so that you know the result.

Reading Challenge: Children are asked to read at home at least 3 times a week to achieve the weekly reading challenge. For us to be sure that they have achieved the challenge, we ask that parents record their child's reading with any comments in the reading diary.

Times Tables: The children will have speed tests on their times tables on most days but extra practice at home will ensure the facts are embedded. By the end of Year 2, the children need to be able to recall the 2, 5 & 10x tables' facts, at speed.
