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STRATEGY STATEMENT AND PLANS FOR EXPENDITURE

We are using this catch up premium to:

- Provide children with Speech, Language and Communication support individualised plans £432
- Provide small 1 to 1 intervention of reading, writing and maths support at a cost of £2,592
- Across the whole school to promote social interaction and team building to provide a Commando Joe inspired curriculum for at least half a term, per term (as identified by parents from the questionnaire in April 2020 and from pupils during class discussions in June 2020) covered by Sports Premium funding
- Across the school re-establishing friendships, including additional staff at lunchtimes to support social interaction at a cost of £824.28
- Stimulating reading interest in year 5 and 6 with author 'virtual visit' at a cost of £75

The overall aims of this catch up premium strategy is

- To improve specific children's speech and language development
- To support reading, writing and maths of children with specific curriculum needs and to further support children who have struggled to access online learning due to their stage of development
- To support relationships, encourage resilience at lunchtimes
- To stimulate curriculum interest in reading for boys by accessing a virtual visit from a male author
- To raise the attainment of all pupils to close the gap created by COVID-19 school closures
